
REAR FACING CAR SEAT

Always read the vehicle owner's manual and the car seat instructions before installation. Your child must meet the height and weight requirements of the seat.

Once installed, push and pull at belt path to ensure that the base (or car seat) doesn't move more than 1".

Harness straps should fit snugly. You should not be able to pinch any extra material at the straps.



3

Ensure that the car seat is installed at the correct angle, indicated by an angle indicator or horizontal arrow on the side of the car seat.

Do not place toys and mirrors close to the car seat. These can injure a child in an accident.



4

Harness straps must be flat, at or below the child's shoulders and buckled. Chest clip must be at armpit level.



7

Babies MUST be rear-facing until age 2. Always ensure your child is within the maximum height and weight requirements of the seat.
