Pediatric Transports


-  Two copies of the face sheet
- Copy of child's chart:
 - Admission record
 - Transfer/discharge summary
 - Medication record, including orders and administration history
 - Lab results
 - Ultrasound/X-ray films/CD
 - Flowsheet
- Signed consent in absence of parent or legal guardian

Neonatal Transports

-  Two copies of the face sheet
- Copy of infant's chart:
 - Admission record
 - Transfer/discharge summary
 - Medication record, including orders and administration history
 - Lab results
 - Ultrasound/X-ray films/CD
 - Flowsheet
- Copy of maternal record, including prenatal labs and H&P
- Copy of delivery record
- California Perinatal Transport form (CPeTs)
- Signed consent in absence of parent or legal guardian

Maternal Transports

-  Two copies of the face sheet
- Transfer form signed by M.D.
- Copy of patient's chart:
 - Admission record
 - Prenatal records
 - Transfer/discharge summary
 - Medication record, including orders and administration history
 - Lab results
 - Ultrasound/X-ray films/CD
 - Flowsheet
- IV established with 18g
 - Could be saline lock
 - With extension tubing
- EFM
 - Have patient on monitor if >24 weeks
 - Tracing available for review
- Medications
 - What has been given (history)
 - What was last given (most recent)
 - Most recent vital signs
